As a member of MTCCA, you receive the following important benefits:

- **The member rate at all MTCCA sponsored workshops.** MTCCA sponsors several educational webinars and workshops each year at various locations to serve the wide geographic area of our membership. Taught by experienced clerks, representatives from State agencies and MMA legal staff, these classes keep us up to date on the latest developments related to our profession.
- **The MTCCA website www.mtcca.org.** This site offers information about county associations, the Clerk's Certification Program, the mentoring program, upcoming workshops, the MTCCA Constitution and Bylaws and more.
- **E-mail listserv program.** This service allows you to post questions, ask for information and communicate with other clerks all around the state. This committee fights for you on issues ranging from fees we collect for hunting/fishing licenses, to legislation regarding election law.
